The Society has a partnership with **Salem Public Library**. WVGS's collection is housed at Salem Public Library. This includes books, microfilm, microfiche, and CDs. These items are listed in the on-line catalog, but are for library use only. **Membership** includes the monthly *WVGS Newsletter* and four issues per year of the Society's publication, **Beaver Briefs**, available to members on our website. To receive **Beaver Briefs** in the mail, include an additional \$6.50 for postage. WVGS maintains a separate collection of family histories and periodicals (see our website for the databases). Salem/Keizer area members can check out books and periodicals from the WVGS collection.

The Society also assists with **research** for a fee. Marion County references, such as Marriage Records 1849-1900, Marion County Census for 1895 and 1905, and other records, are checked for \$10.00, A search of other Oregon counties can be done for \$10.00 or a search of **Beaver Briefs** for \$10.00. Fees for other searches such as obituaries or an Oregon Death Certificate (1906-1964) are \$5.00 each. All other research is \$10.00 per hour.
