## RESOLUTION NO. 12-48

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; NAMING FIRE STATION 73, LOCATED AT 1090 CITY CENTER BOULEVARD IN HONOR OF MICHAEL L. ERTZ, FORMER FIRE CHIEF; PROVIDING THAT THE FIRE STATION BE NAMED THE "CHIEF MICHAEL L. ERTZ, FIRE STATION 73"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Manager Kenneth Parker came before the City Council on August 21, 2012 seeking to name Fire Station 73 in honor of former Fire Chief Michael L. Ertz; and

WHEREAS, Chief Ertz was Fire Chief from 1983 to 2003; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, the introduction the Advance Life Support Units; Community Flu Shots; Public Education Programs; Computerized Reporting and Mobile Computers in the Fire Apparatus were established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ORANGE, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Port Orange, Florida, hereby names Fire Station 73, located at 1090 City Center Boulevard "Chief Michael L. Ertz, Fire Station 73" in honor of former Fire Chief, Michael L. Ertz.

Section 2. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
