COMMENTS: Physician must obtain sufficient detail on all positive responses of relevance to the safe and effective performance of administrative duties, lifting 10 lbs, and possible driving.

During the interview with examinee, the physician must observe and note whether the examinee has any significant communication difficulty (hearing and speech).

The <u>Pre-Placement Results</u> form must be completed, sealed in an envelope, and given to the applicant to take to the hiring department. Include a copy with the medical file sent to Occupational Health Program office.
