Stationary Engineer License – Exam Application

- 1. All Applicants must be 21 years of age and must provide an original signed letter (on company stationary) from their current or former employer's "chief stationary engineer", including the chief engineer's license number.
- 2. The letter must verify the dates of employment and establish a minimum of two years' experience in operation of high pressure boilers. The equipment's steam output per hour, operating pressure, heating surface and maximum allowable work pressure shall be identified, and recite the applicant's duties and responsibilities.
- 3. The Letter must be accompanied by a photo copy of the chief engineer's Stationary Engineer license certificate.
- 4. Provide a check for the \$70.00 examination fee payable to the City of Chicago, Department of Revenue.
