Forest Ecosystem and Society Graduate Program Definition of Satisfactory Academic Progress

Satisfactory progress toward completing a graduate degree in the Forest Ecosystem and Society program requires:

- An annual assessment showing adequate progress in coursework, development of thesis or writing project as evaluated by major professor and the rest of the student's graduate committee,
- Maintaining a GPA of 3.00 or better for all courses taken as a graduate student,
- Successfully passing relevant exams outlined by the Graduate School,
- Timely compliance with all Graduate School and Departmental requirements for committee formation, committee meetings, project proposal, submission of forms and information, participation in seminars and other activities expected of a student, scholar and citizen.

FES Graduate Program Plan for Assessment of Graduate Student Satisfactory Academic Progress

- Early in their program (e.g., at their program meeting) students should collaborate with their major professor and graduate committee to establish standards and expectations of satisfactory progress for that student's program.
- Student progress will be assessed annually.
- An assessment of student academic progress is made by the student, the student's major professor and, if requested, by other members of the student's graduate committee.
- It is the responsibility of the student to complete the Graduate Student Self-Assessment of Academic Progress form, write a self-assessment narrative, arrange to meet with their major professor to review academic progress and to submit the narrative, and signed copies of the Assessment of Graduate Student Academic Progress and Graduate Student Self-Assessment of Academic Progress forms to the departmental office no later than June 30th.

Process:

1. Each spring term, every graduate student in the Forest Ecosystems and Society graduate program will fill out the Graduate Student Self-Assessment of Academic Progress form and attach a written self- assessment narrative. The student may want to discuss their advisor's expectations for various categories of progress or professional development prior to writing the self-assessment.

The written self-assessment should summarize activities undertaken by the student since the last review and should address: (1) Coursework taken and grades received, (2) Field work, data collection/analysis, (3) Progress on writing thesis, (4) Participation in professional development opportunities, (5) Service to the Department and the University and (6) Any other relevant information, including any impediments to progress.

- 2. The student will then schedule a meeting with the major professor to review the student's selfassessment, progress, and accomplishments over the past year. Participation from other graduate committee members may be requested by either the student or the major professor, but is not required. If other committee members provide input the student should obtain their signature on the Assessment of Graduate Student Progress form.
- 3. The major professor reviews the student's materials and then fills out and signs the Assessment of Graduate Student Academic Progress form. The student signs the form and is responsible for submitting the narrative, and signed copies of the Assessment of Graduate Student Academic Progress and Graduate Student Self-Assessment of Academic Progress forms to the department office for inclusion in the student's permanent record by June 30th.
- 4. If the student's progress is deemed to be unsatisfactory, the student will work with the major professor to develop a Graduate Education Performance Plan that contains measureable milestones for assessing student academic progress over the course of the year. The plan will also be reviewed and signed by the department head or the graduate program director and filed in the student's permanent record.

OSU Forest Ecosystem and Society Graduate Degree Program Assessment of Graduate Student Academic Progress

It is the responsibility of the graduate student to request this assessment annually. It will serve as an assessment of progress towards completion of degree requirements. All graduate students in the Forest Ecosystem and Society degree program are required to complete an annual review of their academic progress. Participation from the student and the major professor is required. Participation from other graduate committee members may be requested by either the student or the major professor but is not required.

Major Professors should review the student's Graduate Student Self-Assessment of Academic Progress form and written summary of the past years' activities prior to completing this form. This form is intended to evaluate the student's progress towards program completion and will be placed in the student's permanent file.

This form should be completed each year at the conclusion of an annual meeting or a one-on-one discussion that the student has scheduled.
