RESIDENTIAL EXEMPTION

DESCRIPTION

Each year, at the option of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, an exemption of not more than 30% of the average assessed value of all Class One, residential parcels, may be applied to residential parcels that are the principal residence of taxpayer as of January first. The intent of the exemption is to promote owner occupancy.

The Residential Exemption is a dollar amount of value that is exempt from taxation. For example, in Fiscal Year 2013, a home valued at \$400,000 and eligible for a Residential Exemption would have had \$140,534 deducted from the property's assessed value. This saved qualified homeowners \$1,885.97 on their tax bill.

The Residential Exemption is in addition to any other exemption that a taxpayer may be entitled. In no event, however, may any parcel of real estate be assessed for less than ten percent of its fair cash value. This Residential Exemption credit is applied to the third quarter tax bill. Property owners who do not receive such a credit on this bill and believe they qualify, must file a Residential Exemption application with the Assessors' Office.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR FY 2014?

A taxpayer who owns and occupies residential property as their principal residence as of January 1, 2013 may apply for this exemption.

For the purpose of this exemption, **the principal residence is the address from which your Massachusetts STATE Income tax return is filed.** To verify eligibility, a copy of your **2012 STATE return is required.** You may remove your Social Security number and any financial information that is on your return.

An individual owner may qualify for a residential exemption on ONE parcel only.

WHAT FORMS ARE REQUIRED?

The Residential Exemption Application and required documentation list is available in the Assessors' Office or may be **downloaded** from the forms library site on the city Assessors' Department page.

WHEN MUST AN APPLICATION BE FILED?

An application for residential exemption must be filed with the Assessors Office within three months of the mailing of the third quarter (actual) tax bill.

APPEAL OF THE ASSESSORS' DECISION

You may appeal the disposition of your application. The disposition notice will provide you with further information about the appeal procedure and deadline.

FY2014 Residential Exemption Documentation (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

To qualify for a FY2014 residential exemption, you had to own and occupy your property on January 1, 2013. To confirm your residency, you must submit a copy of your calendar year 2012 State of Massachusetts Resident income tax return, (not Federal). The form must be a copy of the return filed showing your name and the address in question on the front side and your signature or your accountant's signature at the bottom of the page. You do not need to submit copies of other schedules and should feel free to withhold your financial information and social security number. If you filed electronically or filed an extension, you should be able to provide us with a copy of same.

In addition to your required tax return, you **must submit at least one (1) of the following documents. Please pay close attention to the types of acceptable documentation and the dates of the documentation noted in bold**. Failure to submit the right documentation will delay the processing of your application. All submitted documents including your tax return are **not** open to public inspection.

-Automobile registration showing your name at the address in question with an effective date prior to **01/01/13**.

-Telephone bill addressed to you at the property in question covering the period that includes 01/01/13.

-Other utility bill, (gas, electric, or cable television) addressed to you at the property in question covering the period that includes **01/01/13**. Note that utility bills must show where the bill was sent not just where the service is provided, (you may need to contact your utility company). Water and property tax bills are not acceptable.

-Verification of voter registration showing your name and the property in question with a date prior to **01/01/13**.

-Checking statement, (not mortgage statement) addressed to you at the property in question covering the period that includes 01/01/13. Feel free to withhold financial information.

Please note that the Somerville Board of Assessors reserves the right to require additional documentation.
