The 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division Association (FMDA) was incorporated in 1947 by WWII Guadalcanal veterans who served in the famed "Blue Diamond Division." The FMDA is a 501 (c) (19) non-profit veterans organization.

The FMDA is open to membership to all those who served in the 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division or in an attached or supporting unit in any era since its formation in 1941. The purpose of the Association is to foster, encourage, and perpetuate the history and traditions of the United States Marine Corps, to foster patriotism and love of country, and to perpetuate the spirit and comradeship in arms of members of the First Marine Division.

The mission of the 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division Association is to raise scholarship funds to assist the dependents of 100% disabled or deceased 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division veterans in furthering their education. Since the inception of the fund, nearly 700 students have received grants totaling in excess of \$2,000,000.00. The FMDA Scholarship Fund itself is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation.
