WHO CAN APPLY

The program is open to manufacturers in Brown, Calumet, Door, Florence, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Oconto, Shawano and other Northeast Wisconsin counties. Nominees must be manufacturing companies headquartered in these counties or with significant operations located there. Previous award winners are encouraged to apply in other award categories in subsequent years and in the category for which they have received an award in the third subsequent year. 2015 MANUFACTURING AWARDS OF DISTINCTION

AWARD CATEGORIES

A total of four award winners will be selected by an independent panel of judges. Companies will be separated into three categories based on size, with one award going to the best company in each category. A fourth Judge's Choice award will be given to a company demonstrating leading best practices in the area of workforce development. Categories are as follows:

By Company Size

Small (1-99 employees) Medium (100-299 employees) Large (300 or more employees)

Judge's Choice Award for Workforce Development

Many of our area manufacturers report difficulties in recruiting and retaining the skilled employees they need. The Judge's Choice Award for Workforce Development is designed to provide recognition for extraordinary, exemplary and innovative training and education programs which encourage individuals to pursue a career in manufacturing and/or enhance an individual's manufacturing skills. Manufacturers should apply for this additional award if you excel in areas of workforce planning and staff development, investing in talent management and employee development, or developing community-based partnerships. The additional 500-1,000 word profile should detail your workforce development initiatives and outcomes.

SPECIAL AWARDS

In previous years, judges have found outstanding traits in others areas such as innovation, exportation, community involvement and manufacturing support when they reviewed the nominations. At the judge's discretion, they may honor a company with a Special Award for excelling in an outstanding area. There is not a separate application process for these Special Awards. All applications should be written seeking a regular award honoring overall manufacturing excellence.

AWARD PRESENTATIONS

The 2015 winners will be announced at the awards banquet on Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2015 at the Radisson Hotel & Convention Center in Green Bay. Representatives from all nominated companies, their nominators and guests will be invited to attend this business formal event.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Review the Required Nomination Form for complete details. The judges will determine winners based on the content, completeness and quality of the nomination materials. Your complete responses to all criteria, including company financials, are necessary for the judges to accurately evaluate all of the nominees. Nomination information will be used in promotion of the Manufacturing Awards of Distinction program, including media releases, winner profiles and event speeches. Proprietary detailed financial information will be kept confidential. However, Advance reserves the right to generally describe a nominee's financial position. For example: "The company's revenue increased by 10 percent last year." Judge's decisions are final, and they reserve the right to withhold an award in any category if there is not a suitable winning entry.
