The University of Brighton Student Employability Fund

A new fund has been established by the Development and Alumni Office at the University of Brighton which will help **<u>final year students</u>** enhance their employability.

The fund seeks to provide modest non-repayable grants to eligible students to assist in the following ways:

- to contribute towards travel and subsistence costs for students attending job interviews or undertaking unpaid work experience and/or volunteer experience
- to enable students to access specialist equipment and/or facilities related to professional practice
- To attend short courses that have the potential to improve employability confidence, assertiveness, or skills like IT
- Studio time, music or radio, to add to a portfolio
- Specialised software or equipment e.g. recording equipment to help , say, Media students, who want to be self-employed
- Setting up website to showcase work
- Travel expenses for Momentum students with distant mentors, eg travelling to London.
- to help in the purchase of appropriate clothing/footwear for interviews

<u>PLEASE NOTE - the above is not an exhaustive list - any proposals which enhance student</u> <u>employability will be considered.</u>

Grants of up to £250 per student can be applied for using the template application form. Applicants will be ranked by financial need **AND** the proposed impact of the grant requested. The financial situation of students will be assessed based upon the information gathered at the point of entry to the university by Student Services.

A panel of university staff will meet to consider the anonymised applications co-ordinated by the university's Careers Service. The decision of the panel will be final.

The deadline for applications is noon on Friday 7th December 2012.

Each grant recipient will be asked to write a testimonial about the impact of their grant – these testimonials will be used anonymously to promote the fund with a view to secure additional philanthropic donations. The recipients will have an opportunity to meet with the donors if they wish to.
