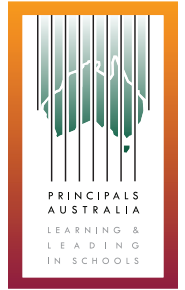

Engagement - What are the critical factors in the successful teaching of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students? What makes for a successful teacher of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students? What are the factors that lead to a successful Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander learner? How do schools and teachers engage their Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities in the process? What is the place of traditional and ongoing Cultural knowledge, heritage, Identity, Spirituality and Language in the school engagement of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students? What role do relationships play in the classroom?

This conference aims to bring together current theory, research and school based successful practice.
