

General Information: To qualify for Modified Collector Vehicle Status:

Before completing this form, please ensure that your vehicle meets the Eligibility Criteria for Modified Collector Vehicle Status. If it does not, and you wish to apply for a Modified Vehicle Status only, you must complete an Application to Register a Modified Motor Vehicle (MV1437 Form). There is no fee for this application.

If your application is approved, a collector plate will be sent to the broker noted below. If we don't have *all of this information*, we won't know who to send your plate to. If the plate is not claimed within 90 days, the broker will return the plate to ICBC.

Step 2: Confirm motor vehicle age.

Step 3: Vehicle modifications

If you're unable to locate an original manufacturer's public VIN on your motor vehicle, you must:

- Submit the MV1325 and a cheque or money order for \$25 (payable to ICBC) with this application.

Step 5: Confirm motor vehicle original body.

My motor vehicle is complete with all body panels, including permanently attached fenders.

Note: Motor vehicles that have had their body, coach or cab replaced with an aftermarket body (for example, steel, fiberglass or carbon fiber bodies) **are not** eligible for modified collector vehicle status. Motorcycles, replicars, replikits, kit cars, motorhomes and vehicles not fully assembled are also not eligible.

Step 6: Attachments

The following support documents must be attached to this application where applicable (submit copies and retain the originals for your records):

I have attached a passed Vehicle Inspection Report from a Provincial Designated Inspection Facility (also keep a copy in the vehicle).

I have attached my receipts, bills of sale, and invoices for major modifications made to the suspension, drivetrain, engine, brakes, body panels, and fuel type.

I have attached a weigh scale certificate, as it is required for all fuel conversions (may also be requested for other vehicle modifications).

I have attached a completed application for a BC Assigned VIN (MV1325) and cheque/money order for \$25, if applicable (see VIN section above)

Step 7: Take photographs of your motor vehicle.

Poor quality photographs will result in your application being returned without review.

The attached colour photos are of my modified motor vehicle and show the side view, front view, engine compartment and interior (including driver's compartment) and the photos accurately show the current condition of the vehicle.

Please visit the modified collector vehicle web page at icbc.com for examples of good quality photographs. All photographs, including digital images, must be taken within 3 months of mailing your application and be:

- clear and detailed
- in colour
- a minimum size of 4x6"
- printed on glossy paper

Note: You will be required to provide additional close up photographs if the photographs you submit do not provide clear detail of your vehicle's condition.

Motor Vehicle Photographs

Colour photographs for each of the following (minimum 11 photographs in total):

Exterior Interior

- entire front view
- trunk with lid open (or tailgate open)
- entire rear view
- engine compartment
- entire right side (may require two or more photographs)
- if convertible model, convertible top up
- entire left side (may require two or more photographs)
- entire dashboard (including radio and steering area)
- all seats (non-factory seat covers removed)
- driver's side floor (mats removed)
- headliner

Step 8: Confirm motor vehicle condition requirements.

- Vehicle exterior** — My motor vehicle has no dents, paint blemishes, bubbling, chips, rust, or visible primer. Body repairs to the vehicle are completed according to professional practices and standards. If there is a convertible top it is not damaged and in good working order.
- Engine compartment** — My motor vehicle's engine is clean and free of rust.
- Vehicle interior** — My motor vehicle's interior is complete and in excellent condition with no tears, stains, or significant wear and tear and is neat and clean. Minor neat repairs to the original upholstery are acceptable.
- Advertising** — My motor vehicle has no advertising of any kind.
- Performance Enhancements** — My vehicle is not equipped with nitrous oxide.
- Flat Black Paint** — The exterior of my vehicle has not been painted with black primer or black epoxy primer.

Step 9: Confirm motor vehicle use requirements and declare general transportation vehicle.

- My Modified collector motor vehicle will be used solely for pleasure purposes and will not at any time be used for driving to or from or part way to or from work or school.
- I own or lease a non-collector vehicle or am the assigned operator of a company vehicle that is registered, licensed and insured in B.C. as my daily transportation vehicle.

Note: If you do not meet the above, you may still display collector plates on your motor vehicle, but your modified collector motor vehicle must be rated for pleasure use only, and must not at any time be used for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school.

Step 10: Complete Statement of Applicant

For licensing purposes:

I declare that I am a resident of the Province of British Columbia and that the motor vehicle described above:

1. Is in, and will remain in a condition that makes it of significant value to a collector of motor vehicles by adhering to the requirements provided in Step 2 and 3.
2. Is registered in British Columbia as a 1958 or earlier model.
3. This motor vehicle has an original vehicle manufacturer's body, coach, or cab.
4. The suspension, drivetrain, engine, brakes, body panels, and/or fuel type have been modified from the original manufacturer's specifications.
5. The attached colour photos are of my modified motor vehicle and show the side view, front view, engine compartment and interior (including driver's compartment) and the photos accurately show the current condition of the vehicle.
6. When licensed as a modified collector motor vehicle will be used solely for pleasure purposes and will not at any time be used for driving to or from or part way to or from work or school.

For insurance purposes:

I declare that when the above described motor vehicle is licensed and insured as a collector vehicle at the reduced collector motor vehicle premiums;

- a) it will be used solely for pleasure purposes and not for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school, and,
- b) I own or lease another licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle, or have a licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle as a company assigned vehicle that is insured for general transportation purposes in one of the following rate classes 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 007, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 017, 021, 022, 023, 024, 027, 310 to 314, or 320 to 324.

WARNING – INSURANCE COVERAGE AND CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY IN THE MODIFIED COLLECTOR VEHICLE PROGRAM

Insurance coverage may be forfeited if the vehicle described above is used contrary to the statements made above under “For Insurance Purposes”. If these conditions are not met, I understand that the vehicle will not be eligible for modified collector vehicle status and the collector vehicle insurance rate class and that I must immediately contact an Autoplan broker to obtain appropriate licensing and insurance for my vehicle.

I acknowledge that if my vehicle is used for more than pleasure purposes at any time, after the initial application and approval as a Modified Collector vehicle, my vehicle is no longer considered to be eligible for the Modified Collector Vehicle Program.

I acknowledge that if my vehicle is approved for modified Collector Vehicle Status, I must continue to maintain my vehicle in the same condition as the date of approval that makes it of significant value to a collector or exhibitor of motor vehicles regardless of age at all times during the original and each subsequent licence/insurance policy term.

Where the owner in this application gives false particulars to the prejudice of the corporation or knowingly misrepresents or fails to disclose in this application any fact required to be stated herein, or uses the motor vehicle contrary to the statement made above, insurance coverage may be forfeited. ICBC reserves the right to apply additional eligibility criteria when determining a vehicle’s Modified Collector Vehicle Status in accordance with the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations.

In signing this application, I declare that all the foregoing statements are true, and that I make these declarations with the intention that the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia will rely on the same.
