Statutory Declaration

The Oaths Act 1936 provides a maximum penalty of four (4) years imprisonment for any person who knowingly makes a Statutory Warning

Declaration which is untrue in any regard.

Under s174A(9) of the Road Traffic Act 1961, if your offence is a parking or stopping offence under the Act or the Australian Road Warning Rules, Council must provide your name to the person you have nominated on this statutory declaration. Council must not provide your address. However, the nominated person might later obtain a copy of your statutory declaration.
