## Portable Storage Units/ Trailer Container <u>Requirements</u>

No Portable Storage unit or similar Container will be allowed prior to issuance of permit by the City of Rock Hill.

## Portable On Demand Storage Units (PODS), Trailers, and Unit Container requirements and conditions:

Portable storage containers of all types shall not be allowed on any property unless a permit has been issued by the City of Rock Hill. The maximum allowed time is 7 days. An extension of one additional period of 7 days will be allowed upon written application for extension.

Adjoining property must be protected at all times from trash and debris.

The storage container will be screened from public view to the greatest extent possible and shall not be a distraction to traffic or create a hazard to the public sidewalks and rights of way. The storage container will be placed off of the public rights of way.

Certain special wastes that are hazardous or toxic shall not be allowed in the Storage containers. Provisions shall be made for the proper storage of this material.

Storage units and trailer containers shall be stored on a hard surface (concrete, asphalt). The area surrounding the containers shall be kept clean, neat, and in sanitary conditions.

Blowing trash and debris will be the responsibility of the applicant to remove from neighboring property and streets

Storage Unit/Trailer Containers shall be removed immediately upon expiration of the permit, unless extended with proper written permission.

Violation of any part of these conditions can result in a court notice and fine as provided in the General Municipal Codes.
