RE: Minimum Impact Expedited Application to NHDES Wetlands Bureau for the project at 91 Gilson Road, Sheet D, Lot 378. Impacts to an unnamed tributary of Lyle Reed Brook (Critical Wetland). The project consists of the extension of an existing 24" culvert to accommodate construction of a sidewalk along the northern right-of-way of Gilson Road. Project involves the installation of sewer lines and new water lines within the existing roadway of the residential manufactured housing community. Several of the roads lie within the 250 feet protected shoreland to the Nashua River, a designated Prime Wetland. Project previously discussed at the September 16, 2009 meeting.
