AWAKENING Wonder Crew Job Description

NOTE: this job description is designed to outline the responsibilities of the position and is in no way inclusive all duties that may be asked of the Wonder Crew. We appreciate your flexibility and dedication in advance.

DATES

Start Monday, August 17 at 9AM sharp – you can move into your Pine Lake housing the evening before. Your room key will be available at the Pine Lake Office on Sunday, August 16. **Finish** Friday, August 28 when you are done; work might go into evening.

This job is a 12-day position with one day off in the middle. The day off will be determined by the Director.

DUTIES

- Prior to Awakening: Clean cabins, move furniture, prepare Pine Lake for the Awakening Program
- Complete tasks pre-Awakening that close summer activities and open the campus for the Fall semester
- Grounds and lawn maintenance. Gardening
- Coordinate logistical aspects of Welcome Ceremony
- Collect breakfast menus and grocery shop for groups
- Deliver breakfast to groups at cabins
- Set up "make-your-own-lunch" materials at breakfast time
- Set up lunch, including laying out all foods (not prepared on platters already)
- Clean up after lunch-making and lunch
- Clean up after dinner (a cook will be there)
- Coordinate bonfires and manage associated risk
- Advise co-directors on facilities needs and problems
- Daily maintenance of lodge and grounds
- Make trips to town for supplies
- Assist with other tasks as they arise
- After Awakening: thorough cleaning of all buildings, and move furniture to prepare for student arrivals
- Thorough cleaning of all "gear" used by the program
- Final preparations for the fall semester

YOUR ROLE

- Make sure Awakening works ... you are the behindthe-scenes IMPORTANT people!
- It's the little things that make Awakening successful and memorable. You do them!
- Report to the Director of Awakening and Wonder Crew Chief; Check in with Pine Lake staff as needed.
- Work flexible shifts depending on what needs doing

EXPECTATIONS

- "Make it fun and get it done"
- Be willing & available to help with tasks as they arise
- Be proactive (do things as they arise, ask for what needs to be done, don't wait until you're asked)
- Follow through on jobs assigned
- Provide your own food for three of the days
