Standardized test scores are also included with the transcript. <u>Lafayette includes all ACT and SAT results unless notes are given by the student under "Special Instructions."</u>

If a college or university asks about suspensions/discipline, we will disclose any out-of-school suspensions or other serious infractions. It is in your best interest to self-disclose these infractions when asked on the application. Please contact your college specialist if you have any questions.

An *official* transcript (one which bears the seal of the school and the original signature of a school administrator) cannot be released directly to a student or parent or guardian. It must be sent directly from Lafayette to the party requesting it. Students and their parents are welcome to request an unofficial transcript at any time.

It is your responsibility to know **ALL** application deadlines for each school to which you are applying – including deadlines for scholarship/financial aid, housing and any other deposits that may be required.
