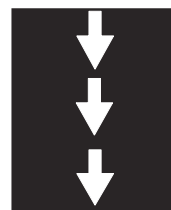


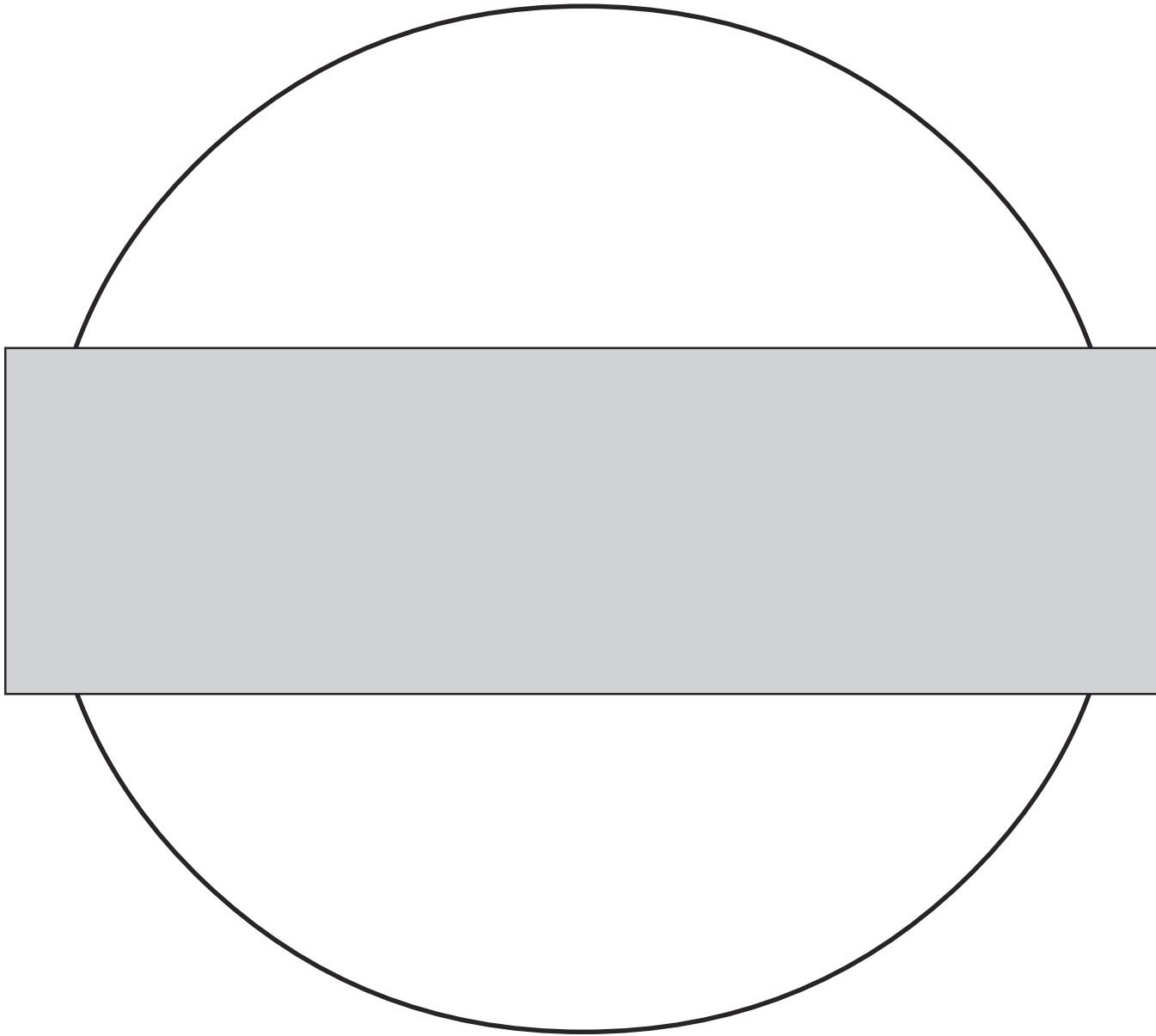
Introductory discussion

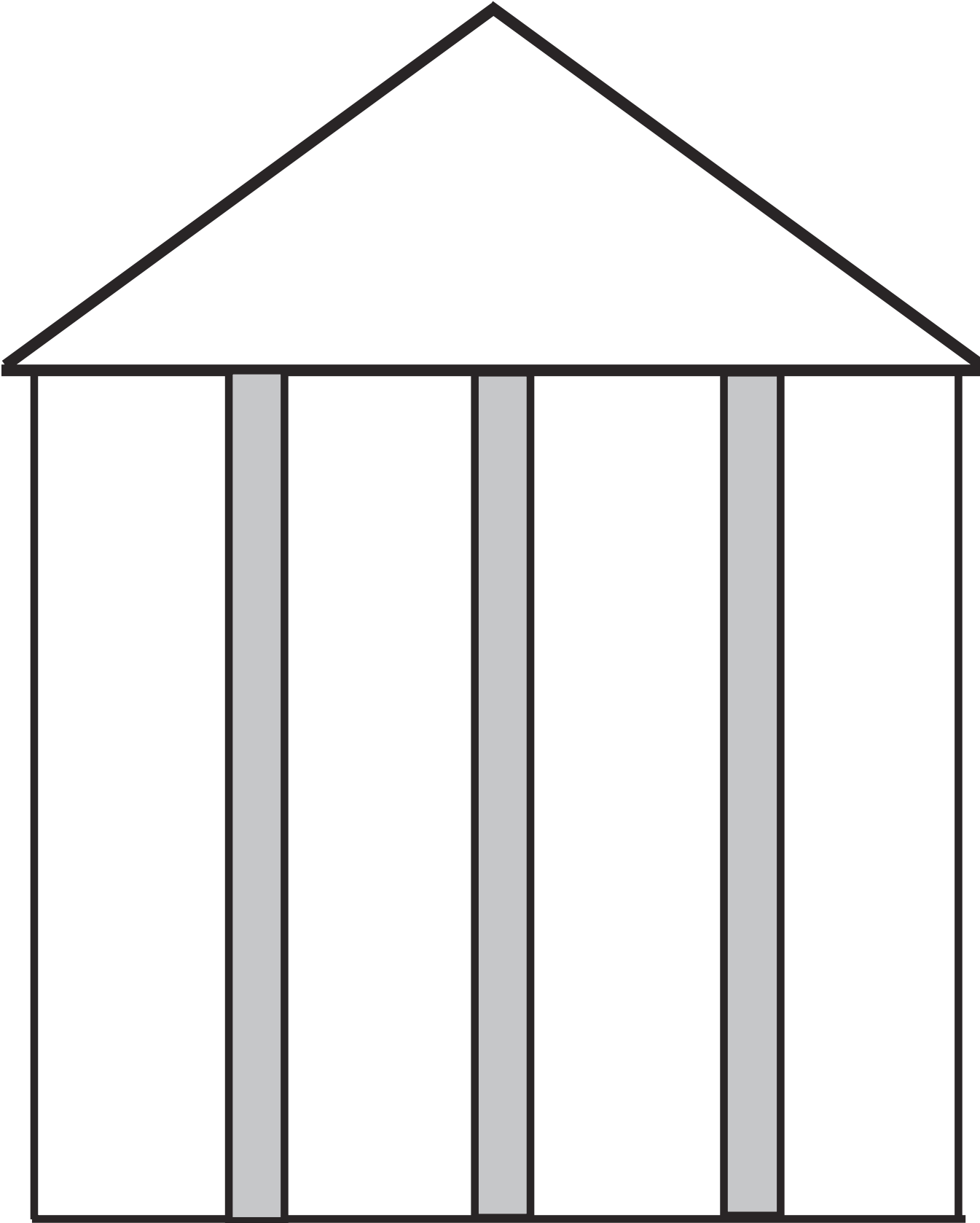

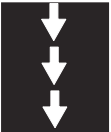


Mountain Region
