IUPUI Graduation Grant Application – December 2016

This grant is restricted to graduating seniors enrolled in 12, 13, or 14 credit hours during their final semester.

Background: Full-time undergraduate students enrolled in on-campus degree programs at IUPUI pay the same amount for their basic tuition when taking between 12 credit and 18 credits. Students are encouraged to take at least 15 credit hours per semester to receive full value under the banded (flat-rate) policy and benefit from savings for hours in excess of 15 credit hours per semester.

The Graduation Grant Application for Banded Tuition Relief has been established for students with unmet financial need who have fewer than 15 credit hours remaining until graduation. Application should be completed and returned to the Office of Student Financial Services. For priority consideration the form should be submitted for review at least 4 weeks prior to the start of the final semester of enrollment prior to graduation.

Eligibility

To be eligible for grant consideration, you must meet the following conditions.

- Current FAFSA on file with demonstrated unmet financial need.
- Certify you have completed and submitted a graduation application with academic unit
- Certify you are eligible to graduate in December 2016 by completing 12, 13, or 14 credits.

You must NOT be eligible for a tuition-specific external scholarship, such as Twenty-first Century Scholarship, which specifically covers the full cost of the banded tuition rate.

If you meet the conditions you will receive consideration for a grant to cover the difference between the cost of banded tuition rate and the per credit hour rate for the number of credits that you will take to complete degree requirements.
