DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

FROM EAST of Sturbridge: Route 90 (Mass Pike) West to Exit 9. Take exit 3B after toll onto Route 20 west. At traffic light at intersection of route 131 and route 20 (at the Motel 8) travel 9.1 miles west on route 20. Take a right onto St. Clair Road and follow the road 1.5 miles up the hill from route 20. St Claire merges with Dunhamtown-Brimfield

FROM WEST of Palmer: Route 90 (Mass Pike) East to Exit 8. Take a right at the light after the toll. At the next light take a left onto Route 20 east. (Brookes Pharmacy will be on your right.) Travel 5.7 miles on Route 20 east to St. Clair Road. Take a left onto St. Clair and follow the road 1.5 miles up the hill from route 20. St Claire merges with Dunhamtown-Brimfield.
