These tests are for Dachshunds and terrier breeds: Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Glen of Imaal, Fox (smooth and wire), Parson Russell, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk, Norwich, Rat Terriers, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, West Highland White. All dogs must be 6 months of age or older and registered with the AKC. Spayed and neutered dogs, dogs with limited registration and dogs with an ILP are eligible to participate.

Introduction to Quarry (non-regular class with no credit toward titles)

Regular classes: **Junior** Earthdog, **Senior** Earthdog, **Master** Earthdog

(Dogs may enter only one regular class, except dogs that have earned a Master Earthdog Title may enter more than one regular class.)

Every attempt will be made to accommodate dogs entered in Intro to Quarry as well as a regular class. However, the test committee cannot guarantee the dog will have the opportunity to run in Intro before being called for its regular class.

For your convenience, a combined entry form is included. Please check which event(s) the dog is to be entered. If the dog is entered in different test(s) on different days, a separate form is needed for each day.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

FROM EAST of Sturbridge: Route 90 (Mass Pike) West to Exit 9. Take exit 3B after toll onto Route 20 west. **At traffic light at intersection of route 131 and route 20 (at the Motel 8) travel 9.1 miles west on route 20. Take a right onto St. Clair Road and follow the road 1.5 miles up the hill from route 20. St Claire merges with Dunhamtown-Brimfield**

FROM WEST of Palmer: Route 90 (Mass Pike) East to Exit 8. Take a right at the light after the toll. At the next light take a left onto Route 20 east. (Brookes Pharmacy will be on your right.) **Travel 5.7 miles on Route 20 east to St. Clair Road. Take a left onto St. Clair and follow the road 1.5 miles up the hill from route 20. St Claire merges with Dunhamtown-Brimfield.**

Travelling 84 East: Take route 84 East to Route 20 west in Sturbridge. See above - *from east of Sturbridge.*
