To apply to be a Retail Vendor at the 2015 Vintage Trailer Show, please complete the attached and mail it, along with the \$200.00 Admission Fee, to the address indicated on the application.

FYI: You can begin merchandising your retail space on Friday, February 20th with booths being assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. You will need to bring: a 10' x 10' booth (ideally with a shade cover); an extension cord (100' recommended, minimum 50'); tables, chairs and anything else necessary to display your products. Please note that your booth must be open Saturday, February 21st from 10:00 am - 4:00 pm, Saturday evening during the Awards Celebration and Sunday, February 22nd from 10:00 am - 3:00 pm with departures anytime after 3:00 pm. Admission fee includes access to electricity & facilities, a private Owner/Vendor Welcome Reception Friday and the on-site Awards Celebration party on Saturday.

NEW THIS YEAR: To capture the increasing popularity of Vintage Trailer Show over the last few years we've decided to hold the Awards Celebration on site at the event space Saturday evening as part of a ticketed event with the trailers & location ablaze with twinkle lights to create a campground environment.
