Day applicants who would like to be considered for our first round of decisions should submit applications by February 1, 2015. Subsequent to that date, applications will be considered on a rolling basis dependent on space availability. Admission decisions will be mailed on March 10, 2015 for all day applicants who meet the February 1 deadline.
