





<u>Secretary's Minutes: Lynn Dorman:</u> Lynn Dorman stated that the minutes of the November meeting were published online. There were no corrections. The minutes will stand as published.

<u>Treasurer's Report: Becky Cozzens:</u> Becky Cozzens reported that the balance on hand is \$16.970.66. There weren't any questions. The Treasurer's report will be filed for financial review.

NRHS is one of only thirty high schools in Ohio to earn this recognition.



NORTH ROYALTON HIGH SCHOOL PTA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE POSITIONS

The Nominating Committee will be meeting soon to fill the slate for the 2015-2016 school year. The slate of officers will be presented at the February PTA meeting and voted on at the March PTA meeting. If you are interested in being considered for an elected position for the next school year, please complete the form on the back of this sheet and return it to PTA Unit President, a member of the Nominating Committee or put in the NRHS PTA mailbox at the high school by January 23rd, 2015.

Following is a list of the Executive Committee positions and a summary of their duties.

PRESIDENT shall represent North Royalton High School PTA at community functions or appoint a representative. The President must fill all committee positions; shall attend workshops for Presidents and a parliamentary procedure course, if available. The President shall make sure that the Bylaws and Standing Rules be amended every two years. The President shall serve on the Budget Committee. The President is a Key Communicator contact for the district for their unit and should pass along information regarding the district as asked.

FIRST VICE PRESIDENT shall represent the unit when asked to do so in the absence of the President. The First Vice President shall be chairperson for the Membership Committee and coordinates annual membership drive. Prepares membership form to be included in student packets in the summer and prepares the form given to staff at the beginning of the school year. Prepares and submits membership information to Ohio PTA. Prepares and distributes membership cards. Establishes membership list and gives a copy to the secretary.


SECOND VICE PRESIDENT shall represent the unit when asked to do so by the President. The Second Vice President shall serve as fund-raising chairperson; which handles the Craft Fair contracts and the publicity, and serves on the Budget Committee.

THIRD VICE PRESIDENT shall represent the unit when asked to do so by the President. The Third Vice President shall be chairperson of the Craft Fair set -up.

FOURTH VICE PRESIDENT shall represent the unit when asked to do so by the President. The Fourth Vice President shall be chairperson of the Craft Fair kitchen.

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SECRETARY shall record and distribute or read the minutes of each meeting. The Secretary should also hold a copy of the Membership List. The secretary shall also give copies of the minutes for the financial review committee. The Secretary shall read or pass around the correspondence at the meetings. The secretary will write letters as directed by the President or the members and shall be responsible for acknowledging the high school staff at the holidays. The secretary shall send notice of all meetings including: general membership, executive board, executive committee and special meetings in accordance with the bylaws.

TREASURER shall keep books for the North Royalton High School PTA and at each meeting have a treasurer report and list of expenditures. The outgoing Treasurer shall obtain the signatures required by the bank for the transfer of authorization of the PTA checking account. The outgoing and incoming Treasurers will also serve on the Budget Committee. The outgoing Treasurer shall file the taxes for the unit by November of the next school year.

COUNCIL DELEGATE/ ALTERNATE DELEGATE shall represent their unit at the PTA Council meetings. The Council Delegate shall personally contact an alternate delegate to represent the unit if unable to attend PTA Council meetings or PTA Council Committee meetings. The President should be contacted if the delegate is unable to find a replacement. A written summary of the council meeting shall be submitted if the delegate is unable to attend the High School PTA meeting to present an oral report. Each delegate is to either be on the Nominating Committee or Founder's Night Committee. An alternate may be requested to be on the Financial Review Committee for North Royalton PTA Council.
