The N.C. Petroleum and Convenience Marketers conducts a project known as "Certified Convenience Store Operator Program." The program's purpose is to provide personnel of member stores a well-rounded education in the c -store industry. The NCPCM Education Committee oversees the "CSO" program and structures seminars to provide training in Human Resources, Marketing, Operations and Shrink Control. Once an employee of a member company completes at least one seminar in each of these areas listed above, he or she will have completed the program.

To date, there are 241 "CSO" graduates. After completion of the program, graduates will be awarded a plaque and a pin in recognition of their continued education.

Besides the advantage of gaining expertise, "CSO" graduates will be offered discounts on future seminars. The program may also help c-store operators negotiate financing by informing bankers that a "CSO" will be managing the stores. From one-store owners to store managers of large companies and personnel in between, all members of NCPCM are encouraged to become certified.
