| Place stethoscope in ears and diaphragm over artery (not under cuff) |  |  |  |
| Palpate radial artery. Inflate cuff until pulse is no longer felt and note <br> number |  |  |  |
| lnflate cuff 30 mm Hg above the number, turn valve counter-clockwise <br> and slowly deflate cuff at even rate of 2-4 mm per second |  |  |  |
| Note point where you hear the first sound as the systolic number. Note <br> the point where the heart sound disappears as the diastolic reading |  |  |  |
| Deflate cuff completely and remove. Disinfect as necessary and return to <br> storage |  |  |  |
| Record both numbers as the systolic/diastolic reading |  |  |  |
| Asks resident if there are any other needs and lets resident know when <br> you are finished |  |  |  |
