American Chestnut Walk

Saturday, October 3, 10:00AM-1:00PM

{Rain date: Sunday, October 4}

The American chestnut was king of the eastern forests before blight all but eliminated it. The roots of those

original trees persist in many areas, like Mariton, and continue to produce saplings. Walk leaders Mike and Kieu Manes have been documenting chestnuts all over the east. We'll collect nuts from a few struggling saplings that will be used for germinating and future planting. Pack a lunch and bring leather gloves as the nuts have very prickly husks.
