Established in 1995\*, the Sewickley Tree Commission is a group of volunteers who make recommendations regarding "...the preservation, maintenance, planting, transplanting and removal of plants, shrubs and trees within the Borough." In addition, **they approve the trimming or removal of Borough trees.**

The Commission continues its efforts to inventory all Borough trees in order to complete a Master Tree Plan for planting and maintenance.

Each year, we host a booth at Sewickley's May Mart where you can stop by for a chance to win a tree.

In the Spring of 2010, 60 trees were planted in public rights-of-way, and the Borough planted 41 additional trees in 2011. We welcome volunteers to join us in our day of Spring planting on April 27 & 28, 2012.

The Commission holds membership with the Southwest PA Community Tree Association, the Arbor Day Foundation and the PA Urban and Community Forestry Council.
