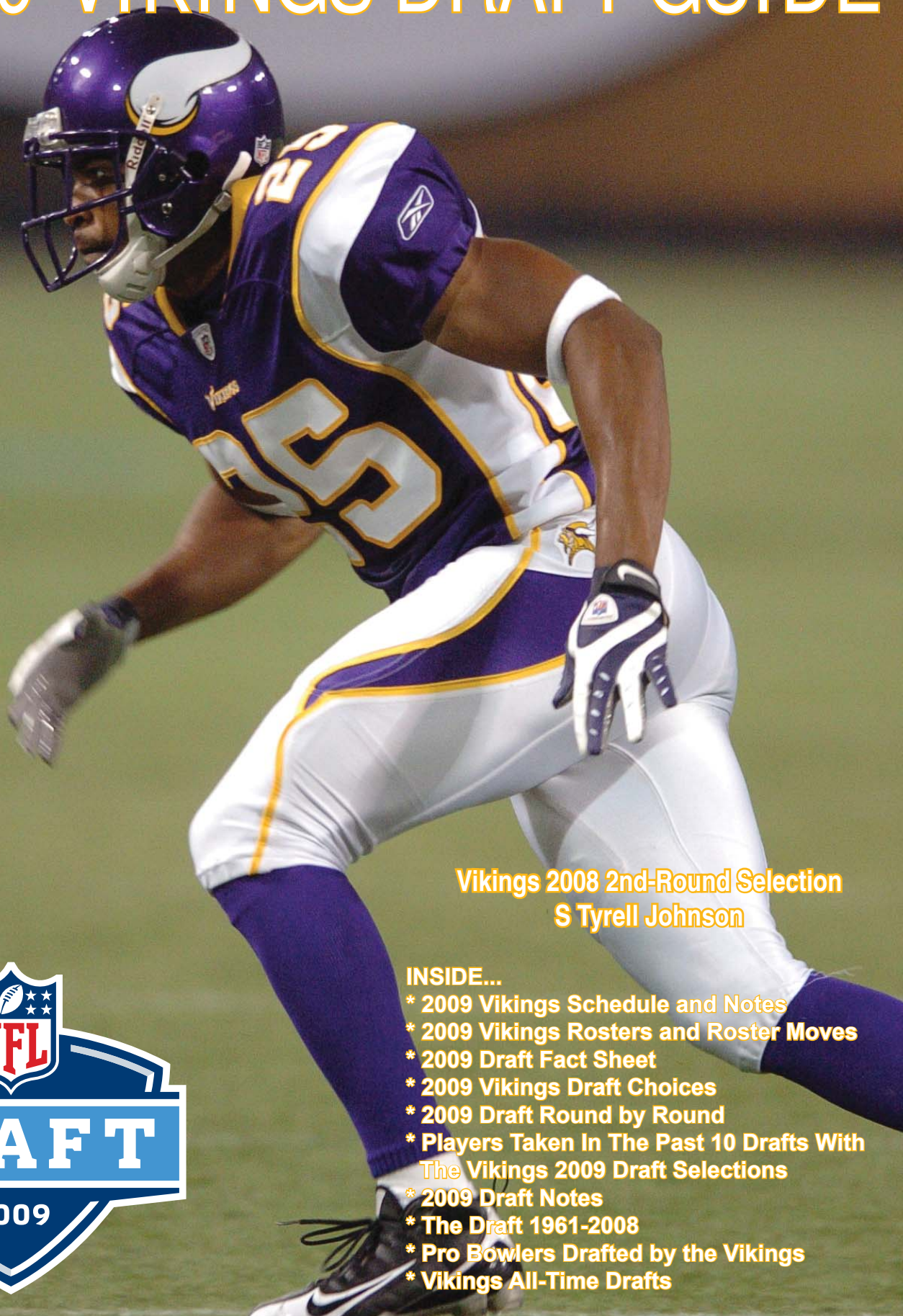

VIKINGS 2009 SCHEDULE NOTES

Date	Opponent	All-Time Series	Notable
9/13	at Cleveland	10-3-0	The Vikings haven't traveled to Cleveland in the regular season since 1989. The Vikings also opened the '83 season in Cleveland, winning 27-21.
9/20	at Detroit	63-30-2	The Vikings have swept Detroit 6 times since 2000, and their 63 wins against the Lions are the most vs. any opponent in the NFL.
9/27	San Francisco	20-22-1	The Vikings are 4-1 in their last 5 at home vs. the 49ers.
10/5	Green Bay	46-49-1	Last November's 28-27 victory at the Metrodome was the 1st over the Packers in the Brad Childress era...In 2 career home games vs. Green Bay, Adrian Peterson has 304 rushing yards (152 avg.) and 1 TD. It is the 2nd straight year the Vikings will face Green Bay on MNF. It will mark the 50th MNF game for the Vikings.
10/11	at St. Louis	22-16-2	The Vikings will face former special teams coord. Paul Ferraro and asst. DL coach Brendan Daly...St. Louis has won 4 of the last 5 matchups.
10/18	Baltimore	1-2-0	The Ravens will make their 1st-ever visit to the Hubert Humphrey Metrodome, and former Vikings' C Matt Birk will spend his 1st time on the visitor's sideline at the Dome.
10/25	at Pittsburgh	8-7-0	1st regular season matchup vs. former Vikings defensive coordinator Mike Tomlin...It will mark the 2nd straight season where the Vikings play the defending Super Bowl champions.
11/1	at Green Bay	46-49-1	The last Vikings victory at Lambeau Field was in 2005, when offensive coordinator Darrell Bevell was the Packers QB coach.
11/15	Detroit	63-30-2	The Vikings haven't lost to the Lions at home since 1997.
11/22	Seattle	4-6-0	Jared Allen had his only career INT vs. Seattle as a member of the Kansas City Chiefs in 2006...In 3 games vs. Seattle Kevin Williams has 3.0 sacks. Chester Taylor had a career-high 169 yards the last time the 2 teams met in 2006.
11/29	Chicago	51-43-2	The Vikings are 14-6 at home vs. Chicago in the last 20 matchups.
12/6	at Arizona	12-9-0	Tarvaris Jackson earned NFC Offensive Player of the Week honors after throwing for a career-high 4 TDs at Arizona on 12/14/2008.
12/13	Cincinnati	5-5-0	Vikings are 4-0 against Cincinnati at home...Besides back-to-back Minnesota victories in 1989 and 1992, the 10-game series has alternated winner and loser, with Cincinnati winning the last contest in 2005.
12/2	at Carolina	5-3-0	The Vikings 2nd-ever trip to Carolina, and 1st-ever prime-time matchup. So far the series has gone in 3- game win streaks, with the Vikings winning the 1st 3 matchups, followed by a Panthers 3-game run, and the Vikings have won the last 2 contests.
12/28	at Chicago	51-43-2	The teams combined for a series-high 89 points at Soldier Field last October. It is the 3rd consecutive year the Vikings will see the Bears in prime-time. The Vikings are 6-4 vs. the Bears on MNF.
1/3	N.Y. Giants	13-10-0	Ryan Longwell's game-winning FG against the Giants (12/28) clinched a playoff berth for the Vikings in 2008. The Vikings are now 2-0 vs. the Super Bowl XLII champs under Childress. WR Bobby Wade's 2 best career games came vs. the Giants with 92 receiving yards in 2006 and 98 in 2008.
