What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough funds in the **Available Balance** of your checking account to cover a transaction, but the credit union pays it anyway. TruMark Financial can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- Overdraft Privilege Program, which comes standard with your account.
- Overdraft Protection Program, such as a link to a savings account or line of credit, which may be less expensive than our Overdraft Privilege Program. To learn more, please ask a credit union representative.

This notice refers to our **Overdraft Privilege** program.

What is the Overdraft Privilege Program?

We **do** authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions (such as ACH transactions) made using your checking account number
- Automatic Bill Payments and <u>Recurring</u> Debit Card Transactions (i.e. monthly bills charged to your card)

We **do not** authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM Transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at <u>our discretion</u>, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we **do not** authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if TruMark Financial pays my overdraft?

Under our Overdraft Privilege Program:

- We will charge you a fee of \$32 each time we pay an overdraft.
- There is **no limit** on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account.
- If you exceed twenty overdraft transactions per month for three consecutive months your Overdraft Privilege will be revoked and TruMark Financial will no longer pay overdrafts on your account.
