### Benefits of the CORE Stipend:

The CORE stipend can be used to pay for tuition, books, or other college-related expenses.

### Requirements:

Students receiving a CORE stipend are required to:

- Conduct themselves, at all times, in a respectful, professional, and ethical manner as outlined in the KCC Student Code of Conduct, and the Code of Ethics for Teachers, Educational Paraprofessionals, & Educational Interpreters.
  - Represent and aim for, at all times, Queen Kapi`olani's and the College's motto, "*striving for the highest*".
  - Attend two mandatory advising sessions with my program advisor per semester.
  - Be actively involved in CORE events, workshops, and institutes.
  - Be a role model and peer mentor to CORE peers.
  - Maintain a 3.0 GPA in all program-related courses and maintain a 2.75 overall GPA.
  - Take at least 6 credits per semester.
  - Attend one SOS budgeting workshop (insert link).
  - Complete an A.A or A.S. degree in one of the CORE programs.
  - Complete a CORE 1+1 Certificate.
  - Fulfill the requirements outlined in the CORE 1+1 Service Obligation Form
- **Important note:** The State fiscal system sometimes sends payments late so students should not count on receiving the stipend at a critical time.
