He said he felt that the compensation was too excessive and the Board should not receive these benefits, especially if it costs the district teachers.

Mrs. Nellans said she had nothing to report at this time because no meetings had been held over the holidays. She thanked Dr. Hendrix for all his hard work in helping the School Town of Munster get back on its feet. She thanked the community as well.

MR. OSTOJIC

Mr. Ostojic thanked everyone for welcoming him.

Dr. Hendrix said that he's been here six months now, and he's really trying to get a handle on finances. He's had several meetings with other superintendents to try to get more money from the state. We all have to figure out we can fix this problem. It won't be easy, but he feels we can get it done. He encouraged everyone to call, email or stop by as he's here to talk.
