Parental Info and Warning

There is a website that a lot of our Lackamas kids are talking about and doing online called "Moshi Monsters". Once you join you get to create cute little monsters and decorate their rooms as well as chat with online friends that you accept. Just a warning...in this day and age, we don't necessarily know who is on the other end of the computer unless they have blatantly identified themselves. If your kids have a Moshi Monster, you might consider having the conversation with them about this and perhaps about other internet safety related items. Additionally, this website is essentially the kids' version of Facebook where postings are placed on each other's accounts and can be read by anyone who "friends" you. As we've seen here at Lackamas with Facebook, cyberbullying can become an issue as well. Again, this might be a great opportunity for you and your student to look through the postings together and discuss internet safety and etiquette.



To end, Mrs. Enlow recently taught a unit on "Cyberbullying" that concluded with a little phrase of what to remember what to do if you feel you are being bullied online:

Don't respond, Tell an adult, Save the evidence, & Block the bully. Back in the day, School House Rock always taught us that "Knowledge Is Power"...so let's help give our kids the knowledge that they need to be safe physically and emotionally.
