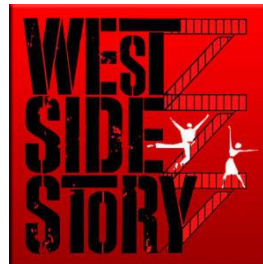

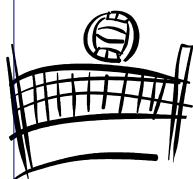

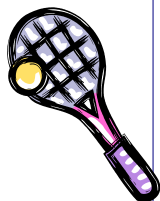


St. Benedict at Auburndale Sports Camps are for young athletes who are looking to improve their skills, work hard, make new friends and have fun!
