Barb graduated from Aberdeen Central High in 1976 and continued her education at Stewarts' School of Cosmetology and earned a degree in cosmetology. She then lived in Colorado Springs for a short time. She returned to Aberdeen and attended Northern State and earned a two year degree in Of-

ice Administration. A few years later, while working for the SD Department of Health, she continued her education at Northern State. She was employed for the Department of Health for eleven years.
