### DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From Interstate 25, exit at Alameda Exit (#233). Head west on Alameda to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. Go north for 9 tenths of a mile, turn right to the Posse Grounds

**ABOUT THE SITE** Both rings will be on packed dirt under a cover. There is crating space available on the north side of the arena, as well as under the bleachers on the south side There is also crating space outside of the covered area. Water is available at the site. Please do not park or set up crates in the fire zone or in the RESERVED PARKING areas that have been DESIGNATED for trial committee and key workers. **NO DOGS IN THE RESTROOMS OR ON THE GRASS AREA IN FRONT OF THE POSSE CLUB HOUSE. FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE TRIAL.**

**AWARDS** Strip ribbons will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> place dog in each jump height in each class. The placement ribbons will conform with the colors set by AKC. Green Qualifying strip ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. MACH Rosette and MACH bars will be presented to handlers finishing a MACH title during the event. Toys valued at one to three dollars will be awarded to all first place winners. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial. No prize/award will be mailed.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR , LIABILITY:** Members of the Sandia Dog Obedience Club, and their agents, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children and guests.

SDOC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against SDOC or any official thereof.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) guest(s) and /or children. Those engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the site. In such cases there will be no refund of fees paid.

In consideration of others you will be expected to clean up after yourself and your dogs at the event site and at your motel. Failure to do so may be cause for dismissal.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) or a PAL number. or Approved FSS Breeds , except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. For details of eligibility refer to Regulations for Agility Trials Chapter 1, Section 3. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

**REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fees will be refunded for dogs withdrawn after the closing date **except** for bitches who come into season or withdraw due to a change of judge(s) , who will receive a refund less \$20 processing fee of entry fees paid , providing the Event Secretary receives notice in writing no later than the day preceding the event. No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the event committee will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

**Faxed, telephoned, or unsigned, or incomplete entries cannot be accepted.** Entries not on the current official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Please no staples, no tape.-. Entries that have excessive tape or staples may be returned.. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. **A maximum of 10 Entries per envelope is allowed.** Envelopes with more than the 10 dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and are subject to an added collection fee

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in chapter 11, section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

**CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES:** All exhibitors with legible e-mail addresses will receive confirmation of entries as they are received as well as e-mail Final confirmation of entries with in 48 hours of the closing date. Those without email may enclose a self addressed envelope for pre closing receipt of entry notice.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS--- CONTINUED

**Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form.**

### **NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

### **How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?**

**If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date:** One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check  My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form  box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

**If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date:** A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the  My dog needs to be measured  box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the  My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card  box on all future entry forms.

**Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:** If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the  Over 22  Reqst Perm  box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the  My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card  box on all future entry forms.

### **What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?**

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

### **May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?**

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - CONTINUED**

**What is the jump height card challenge process?**

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
