



### **CHANGES**

We are not the same today as we were yesterday. Even if we found yesterday precious, nothing lasts forever. Everything that is precious to us changes. Today's liturgy speaks of changes and transformations. More than that, it calls us to be people of change and transformation. This can make for an unsettled life, but it also makes for a life of glory.

### **COMMENT**

The first reading describes a vision of eschatological glory. The "one like a Son of man" is given dominion, glory, and kingship over all things. In this passage we see a portent of the coming of Christ once in time and again at the end of time.

The Second Letter of Peter is addressed to a faith community that has found itself beset by fraudulent teachers and doctrine. One such notion derides the Christian belief in the Second Coming of the Christ, an event the community had considered imminent. The passage reminds the community that the Second Coming is not some fairy tale concocted to fool the faithful. Rather, it is a teaching based on Peter's own first-hand experience of the Transfiguration, which disclosed the Lordship and dominion of Christ. The passage implies that the Transfiguration was a foreshadowing of the final coming. The Transfiguration event and the authenticity of the prophetic message should inspire the community to trust in the advent of the parousia; they will experience a personal transformation when "the morning star rises in your hearts" (2 Peter 1:19).

Today's Gospel passage recounts a crucial revelatory event in the unfolding of Jesus' identity. The three disciples catch a brief glimpse of the glory of the Lord, the fullness of which will not be revealed to humanity until the Second Coming. That coming is also hinted at by the presence of Moses and Elijah. Together, they discuss Jesus' "passage," his suffering and death, which remind us that divine ecstasy—total transformation—is achieved only through divine agony.

### REFLECTION

In the Broadway show *The Music Man*, Marian discovers that she has fallen in love with Professor Harold Hill and sings that she had never heard bells ringing or seen birds winging until she met him. Put simply, Marian underwent a transforming experience because of the presence of another. We have experiences like this as well, experiences that enable us to perceive more definitely, to feel more sincerely, and to recognize more clearly the presence of the One who loves us—the presence of God. Experiences like this are like doors opening into the holy. And they are not as few and far between as we might think. We need only pay attention and realize that no matter where we are, we are in the company of the holy.

Some people would have us believe that no one really changes. A person may alter an attitude or obliterate a bigotry, but the core of the person does not change. Jesus would

not agree. For Jesus, change was and is crucial. It is the hallmark of conversion. It is at the heart of the paschal mystery, of our dying and rising in Christ Jesus. It is precisely what Jesus Christ calls each of us to do. For without change, we cannot enter into the glory of God's reign.
