- 2) Multiple bids for the same item may be made by the Bidder. Please copy the appropriate proposal sheet(s) for the item(s) to be bid with more than one model. The proposal for each item bid must be completed. Please number the proposal sheets accordingly.
- 3) The proposal must be completed and the proposal signature sheet must be signed.
- 4) An informational copy of the contract is provided to the Bidder. Please read it but do not sign it.
- 5) All exceptions or changes to the specifications must be shown on the proposal sheet(s) in the space provided or attached to the proposal sheet.
 - 6) Deviations or alternatives from the provisions of these specifications will be considered, to permit manufacturers to follow their standard manufacturing processes. - 3. The ability of the bidding vendor to directly provide prompt and efficient service and/or part delivery within a 100 mile radius of Ritzville, Washington.
- 4. The quality and history of performance of previous contracts or services (based on past experience and/or references of past ownership records of same or similar equipment.)
- 5. Uniformity or interchangeability.
- 6. All taxes payable by Adams County as a result of the procurement.
- 7. Any other information having a bearing on the decision to award the contract.
- 8. Bidders are advised that Adams County, being a municipal corporation, is exempt from Federal excise tax.
- 9) The price quoted shall include all transportation charges fully prepaid to the Adams County Shop, Ritzville, Washington. Purchaser requires delivery date as stated on the Bid Form. A penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per day for each unit will be assessed the bidder after the date. This sum will be deducted from the final payment for the unit bid. The penalty mentioned herein does not apply to late delivery due to an act of God or a strike at the manufacturer's plant.
- 10) The units bid and all equipment, lights, signal and safety devices shall meet Washington State and Federal requirements.

- 13) Contingent upon the <u>seller's review and approval</u> at the time of a requested sale, Adams County and other political subdivisions of the State of Washington may purchase additional items at the bid price(s). Prices may increase, by a maximum of 10% or

decrease on a pass through basis if mutually agreed upon. Seller's right to refuse to sell additional items at the time of request shall be absolute.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

<u>Contract Period</u>: This contract shall be for a period commencing on the date of order entry and terminating one year from date of order.

<u>Renewal:</u> The Contract may be renewed for four (4) additional one year contact periods, subject to mutual agreement with the total contract period not exceed five years. The Purchaser shall notify the Vendor of the intent to exercise the renewal option in writing, no later than 30 days prior to the purchase of addition units.

<u>Order Date:</u> The order date shall be the date upon which the Public Works Director or his designee signs the form ordering the equipment.

<u>Price Increase:</u> At each renewal opportunity, the Vendor shall inform the Purchaser regarding any anticipated price increases or decreases expected to affect the machines identified under this contract bid. This information shall be provided with sufficient lead-time to make an informed decision to renew or not.

<u>Interpretation:</u> Should discrepancies or omissions be found in the specifications, or any doubt as to its meaning, the bidder shall notify the Public Works Director in writing. The Public Works Director will send written instructions or addenda as required to all interested parties and they shall be incorporated into bid documents.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

The attached specifications are for the purpose of providing details regarding the type of product desired by Adams County. Equal or similar products from reputable manufacturers and suppliers are permitted. Adams County shall be the final determiner of product equivalence.

Any units not conforming to bidders exact specifications will be rejected and it will be the responsibility of the manufacturer and/or bidder to conform with the requirements unless deviations have been specifically cited by the bidder and acceptance made on the basis of the exception.

BIDDERS: Shall submit one (1) copy of each of the following with bids:

- (A) Descriptive literature
- (B) Complete operating dimensions and sketches of unit proposed
- (C) Complete Full specifications, warranties, and pictures of the unit must accompany this bid and dates clearly stated for units proposed.

FULL SERVICE FACILITIES: A full service facility with spare parts inventory must be available to Adams County within 48 hours, during normal working hours, Monday through Friday.

DELIVERY: Units shall be delivered complete with all accessories and components in full operating condition to the Adams County Department of Public Works at Ritzville, Washington, by a qualified service man who will remain until the Adams County personnel are entirely acquainted with all equipment and its operation. Warranty shall not begin until time of acceptance by Adams County.

WARRANTY: Warranty period must be stated on all equipment furnished. The successful bidder shall, at his own expense and without any cost to Adams County, replace all part failures and make all repairs that may be required or made necessary by reason of defective design,

materials, or workmanship, or by reason of nonconformance with the specifications. Warranty claims rectified by the vendor are in turn hereby guaranteed as stated above for the period of the warranty. Defects in design or workmanship, as guaranteed herein, shall be rectified in all units furnished, at a location established by Adams County.

PARTS AND SERVICE MANUALS: Successful bidder shall furnish a complete parts list, service manual and lubrication chart for each new unit furnished. Successful bidder hereby agrees to furnish all subsequent addends as issued.

GENERAL TERMS: Appurtenances and/or accessories not herein mentioned but necessary to furnish a complete unit ready for use upon delivery shall be included in the bid and conform in design, strength, quality of material, and workmanship to what is usually provided to the trade in general. The units furnished shall include, but not be limited to, factory standard equipment and those optional items as specified. Should the manufacturer's current published data or specifications exceed these, they shall be considered minimum and be furnished. All products shall conform to applicable Federal and State safety and health laws, rules and regulations.

DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION PRACTICES: All unit components shall be designed for heavy-duty operation. Materials shall have physical and chemical property compatible with the intended service and with sufficient excess capacity for durability and safety. Adequate section modulus shall be provided in all structural members to support maximum loads under capacity operations at maximum speeds, without damage or permanent distortion. All shafts, gears, and other appurtenances shall have sufficient strength to withstand the maximum imposed torque with adequate margin for safety and durability.

TAXES: All applicable taxes must be shown when called for in proposal. It shall be the dealer's responsibility to furnish Federal excise tax exemption certificate, when applicable.

PAYMENT: Adams County will make Payment within 60 working days after delivery and final acceptance. All interest costs incurred to bidder must be computed in the original price bid as no further compensation will be made.
