If you want to get your money's worth out of that expensive lift ticket, you'll need plenty of cardio endurance. Most of us hit the slopes and plan on skiing all day, even if it's been months or years since we last skied. By afternoon, you're so tired that your legs feel like jello, a prime time for injuries and accidents to happen.

To prepare your heart and body for long-term skiing, your cardio program should include:

- 3 to 5 days each week of your favorite activity. The best for skiing include running, the stairmaster, step aerobics, elliptical trainer and rollerblading.
- A variety of workouts at varying intensities lasting from 20 to 45 minutes.
- One long, slow workout each week for 60 or more minutes to condition your legs and lungs for long days of skiing.

Strength for downhill skiing begins before you set foot on the slopes.

Prepare your body for skiing and you will spend hours on the snow without muscle fatigue.
