"Press Release" from the PTO Board

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Welcome Back!! This year is full of fresh and exciting changes for Folger, with new ways of doing things. We have highlighted some main points that you need to know...

New Principal...Mrs. Bachmann, our new leader!

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- A technology authority! She will blend instruction fundamentals with technology tools and educational software to provide the best educational experience for our children.
- She will lead us through our revitalization. Her experience with school construction and depth of knowledge is so exciting.
- FASST Math a software initiative for the entire school! A comprehensive, computer-based program designed to help students develop fluency with basic math facts. This supplemental program automatically differentiates instruction and practice based on each student's individual fluency gaps. The computer assesses each student and provides adaptive instruction to reinforce conceptual understanding and memory connections of basic math facts with daily 10 minute sessions. We love this program, and wish to support it. To purchase this for the entire school, the cost is \$8,500. (That's where you come in!) The good news is that it can continue to be used at Folger long after its revitalization. Basic math facts don't change. But the way they are presented to our children should change with the times.

Speaking of Fundraising... We listened- and we have a new plan! This year, we are taking a page out of Oak Hill's PTO success and asking our families for a direct donation to the PTO in addition to the dues that are collected at the beginning of the year. If each family donated during our Direct Donation Campaign, we would be well on our way to making our \$25,000 budget. You can help the PTO purchase those math and reading programs that help your children succeed! That's money well-spent!

Direct Donations.... What is it?

- No more wrapping paper, door-to-door sale solicitations from our students or nickel and diming!!
- You can donate all at once or even monthly!
- Your donation is confidential and your business. You give what is right for your family.
- Without traditional fundraising, the responsibility of our funding relies solely on your contributions. MORE GOOD NEWS is that 100% of your donation goes directly to the PTO. No more split donations with a fundraising company!
- Your Direct Donation contribution is 100% tax deductible!! (Your canceled check is your receipt)

What does the PTO exactly do for my child/children?

- Provides funding for Cultural Arts programs
- Offers assistance to needy children
- Maintains school grounds and environmental programs
- Hosts several Family Nights, which strengthen the school community through fun and educational programs.
- Gives the teachers supplemental tools which enable them to be better educators. Items as small as electric pencil sharpeners to United Streaming technology programs and reading programs for Special Ed.
- Invests in extensive school-wide educational programs that would otherwise not be purchased to give our students an educational advantage!

All of this information is provided so that you can know what we hope to achieve for the year. Among other things, we want to get computer technology that is transferable and workable right now. Though we are not selling gift wraps and doing fundraising that requires competitive participation or student prizes- we still need each Folger Family to raise funds to support our school. For those of you who are no longer paying tuition to preschool- here's your chance to help! We hope to achieve our goal of \$20,000 by December 2009 during this campaign to support our annual budget. (Remember, that's a tax deduction!!) If we don't reach our goal, we will have to go with "Plan B". We do have many ideas from energetic parents who are willing to lead a fundraising effort. The only other event that we are planning to keep is our Folger 5K in the spring. That is a community-based fundraiser which is geared to the entire Severna Park community- not just to Folger Families. Anyone who wants to participate is welcomed and encouraged through a web site registration promoting a healthy, active lifestyle. That kind of event can only serve to strengthen the bond between Folger and the community it serves. We invite you to help our children learn and succeed with programs and items that help teachers help our kids! Thank you- for giving this program your best effort!!

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
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Spiritwear
