School assembly plan

Introduction

- Story – Courage Saves Christmas! - a flash card story.
- Ask for festive helpers. Whenever a word is mentioned the pupil has to hold up the flash card and the audience has to respond.
- Game – Pass the parcel. Ask for five festive helpers. The parcel is passed along the line to music. When the music stops, the pupil has to remove a layer. At the end of the game it is revealed that there is a box in the middle without anything in it. Explain to the pupils that there are children in their local area that will not be getting any presents this Christmas.
- Explain Mission Christmas and how they can help.
