Create a comic strip about actions kids and/or adults can take to reduce air pollution from vehicles. Be creative and have fun! Your story should include to one or more of the following actions: No-Idling; Riding a bus; Carpooling; Riding a bike; Walking; Riding the train (i.e. MARTA); Combining car trips

Eligibility:

- Each student or team must have an adult coach (a teacher, parent, etc.)
- Eligible students must be enrolled in a Georgia elementary school (Pre-K- 5) for the 2010-2011 school year. Entries from student support organizations including private, parochial, and home schools are eligible.
- All comic strips will remain the property of The Clean Air Campaign and all entrants must allow The Clean Air Campaign permission to use their submission for public education.

Prizes:

- Winners will be announced during Air Quality Awareness Week, May 2-6, 2011. First, second, and third place videos, as well as honorable mentions, will be chosen by a panel of judges.
- Winning comic strips will be featured on The Clean Air Campaign's website, social media channels, and printed materials showing your talent off to more than 100,000 people!
- Donations will be made to each winner's school science, environmental, or art program.

Submission Requirements:

- Use the attached comic strip template to create a three- to six-block comic strip. Comic strips
 must include text telling the story. You can also use speech, thought, and exclamation bubbles
 to help tell the story. Comic strips should address air pollution from vehicles.
- 2. Comic strip drawings can be in black and white or color, but must be on white paper. All stories and artwork must be original and created by students.
- 3. Entries can be submitted by individuals or small teams of up to 6 students.
- Each comic strip must be accompanied by a completed entry form. Entries can be mailed or scanned and sent as a PDF electronically. All entries must be postmarked by April 15, 2011.
 Entries postmarked after this date will not be considered.


