If the legal owner of the horse wishes to terminate this agreement prior to the expiry date shown above, the owner must advise the 4-H member of the reason for terminating. Also, the owner and lessee must advise the 4-H member's club leader and the chairman of the Northwest Regional Light Horse Committee of the reason for terminating the lease. This should be done within two weeks.

If the above noted horse is boarded at the owner's residence, the 4-H member will be allowed the following:

1. access to the horse
2. to remove horse from owner's premises to attend clinics, club rides, Achievement Day, regional show and other 4-H events agreed upon by the owner and the 4-H member.

The owner and the 4-H member shall discuss and mutually agree upon the following:

1. The standards of care and maintenance of the horse
2. Need for and conditions associated with insuring the horse.

If tack is also being leased, list all tack and value on the back.

Reminder: Provincial 4-H Policy 6.06: "Appropriate project records must be kept for a minimum of one hundred and eighty (180) days as per the 4-H Alberta equine record keeping guidelines for each animal. 4-H members must be responsible for providing the major part of the feeding, care, and management for their animals. (Check with your local club for clarification)."
