SPEECH GUIDELINES

- ❖ The student must have attended Madera High during his/her entire Junior and Senior vear.
- ❖ The speech must incorporate the theme picked by the senior class.
- Speeches must be respectful and positive to <u>all</u> students, staff, and the Madera community.
- Speeches should not include inside jokes. The speech will not be given consideration if the judges don't know what you are talking about.
- ❖ Speeches may be no longer than 3 minutes if given in a single language.
- Speeches given in two languages may be no longer than four minutes total.
 (ex. 2 minutes in Spanish and 2 minutes in English)

TIMELINE

April 29 Turn in application and typed speech to the Activities Office.

**The speech must be typed, 12pt. font, times new roman, double spaced.

April 30 Speech Competition @ 3:15pm in the Theater

- Speeches will be judged on quality of thought, organization of thought, vocal delivery, physical delivery and overall effectiveness.
