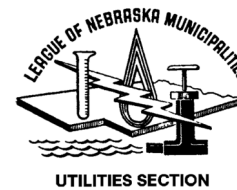

About the Workshops

**Gas, Electric, Parks, Street, Water
and Wastewater departments**

These confined space workshops meet the requirements for recertification hours for water and wastewater operator licenses, natural gas operator qualification programs, and electric line worker annual training. All participants will receive certificates recognizing training on confined space identification, monitoring, safety equipment and safety requirements before entry of a confined space. Some basic emergency rescue procedures will be also be addressed.

Participants will receive five hours of continuing education credits and should maintain their certificates as a record for their training file.

Registration and Fee

Participants are welcome to preregister no later than one week before attending the workshop of their choice. Registration also will be available at the door on location of the workshop. Fees for the workshops are \$35 per person, which includes breaks, lunch and learning materials. Fee may be prepaid or directly billed.
