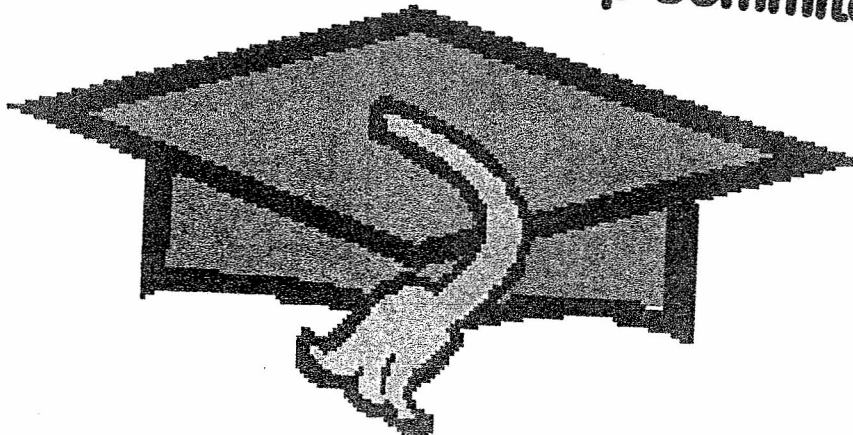

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**SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The Grumman Retiree Club Scholarship Fund, Inc. will awards scholarships this year to high school students graduating June 2012 and accepted for college acceptance. Scholarships will be awarded by the Scholarship Fund, Inc. and the Bethpage Credit Union. All school transcripts must be sent directly from the High School Guidance Department to:

**1. BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** The applicant must be a child, grandchild or great-grandchild (legally adopted and stepchildren are included) of a Retiree Club member or spouse, who has been a member of the Grumman Retiree Club for the last two years.

The applicant must be graduating high school and going directly into a fully accredited two or four year college or university as a full time student.

**2. SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:** The applicant must be in the top 25% of his/her graduating class and have an unweighted average of 85% (2.5 on a scale of 1-4). This record must be sent to the Scholarship Fund directly from the high school office.

**3. RECOMMENDATIONS:** Scholarship Fund, Inc. must receive letters of recommendation from student's teacher/instructor no later than May 16, 2012. Additional letters of recommendation are optional.

**4. COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE:** Scholarship Fund, Inc. must receive a copy of applicants acceptance letter from the college or university of his/her choice (if not available at the time of submittal, do not delay forwarding completed paperwork) Awards will be made directly to that college/university.

**5. DEADLINES:** All completed applications and required documentation must be received by the Scholarship Fund, Inc. no later than May 16, 2012.

**NOTE: Submittal of application Materials:** Applications should submit synopsis of their activities (100 words or less), letters of recommendation, college acceptance letter and high school transcript as soon as documents are available.

**\*IMPORTANT:** Do not wait to have a complete package to submit. A folder for each applicant will be started with the submittal of the first document.
