## **Long-Term Prescription Programs:**

#### **Jackson County Prescription Discount Plan**

Jackson County Health Department 1715 Lansing Ave., Suite 221 Jackson, MI 49202 Service: provides *discount* (average 24%) on prescription drugs whenever the prescription is *not* covered (even partially) by insurance. Cannot use card to reduce insurance co-pays. May use out of county, too. Eligibility: Jackson resident. No income or age restrictions. Fee: none Enroll: at website <u>www.nacorx.org</u> then click "print a card now." Enter zip code and click submit. Enter name and email address, then print ID card. If no internet access, visit Health Dept. reception desk to pick up free card.

Jackson St.Jackson, MI 49201Service: Prescription coverage and health care for low-income adultswithout Medicare (see next entry on Medicare D.)Eligibility: Income guidelines: less than \$1313 income per month forsingles; Income less than \$1770 per month for couples. No asset test.(Income guidelines for 2014.)

#### **Medicare Prescription Coverage**

Service: Offers prescription drug insurance to anyone with Medicare. The standard benefit requires a monthly premium (about \$40/month), a yearly deductible of \$310, then Medicare pays about 75% of the first \$2,850 in prescription costs (2014 figures.) Folks with low incomes and low resources may qualify for government help paying the premium, deductible and copays. Annual enrollment period is October 15-December 7. For help comparing and/or enrolling in Medicare drug plans, or to see if you qualify for extra help, you may call the **local** Medicare/Medicaid assistance program (MMAP) at **1-800-803-7174**.

### **Health Pay**

Center for Family Health 505 N. Jackson St. Jackson, MI 49201 Service: provides a discount on prescriptions and health care. Co-pays vary depending on income, family size and type of medication. Must fill prescription on site at Center for Family Health Pharmacy. Eligibility: Must be patient of primary doctor at Center for Family Health and without prescription coverage

#### Veterans Prescription Coverage and Health Care 788-4425

Veteran Affairs 1715 Lansing Ave., Suite #265 Jackson, MI 49202 Service: Prescription coverage with \$9/month or less co-pay for VAapproved generic drugs. Drugs are mailed to veteran. Eligibility: military veteran of active duty, either disabled or with income (after medical expenses) less than \$31,443 if single, less than \$37,733 if married (from 2013 tax figures), and resources less than \$80,000. Must have VA appointment at Ann Arbor or Jackson location; wait list may pertain.

#### **Pharmaceutical Company Programs**

Pharmaceutical companies may offer "**patient assistance programs**" that provide 30-90 day supplies of medicines delivered to the doctor for qualifying low-income seniors who do not have drug insurance. Application process is lengthy and involves doctor's staff as well as client to complete. Contact the national office of the drug company or <u>www.needymeds.org</u> for the eligibility criteria.
