In order for your speech to qualify, it is important that you are familiar with the Graduation Committee's expectations and the criteria for evaluation. Please review the following points:

- Written speeches are judged "blindly" (without a student's name attached). **Your name should appear on a cover sheet only**).
- Each presentation should be no more than 3 minutes in length. (Typed or word processed speeches please.)
- Graduation speeches should be about Graduation, and/or related themes. No personal or religious messages, political speeches, or time to bear old wounds and/or degrade anyone or the school. No profanity will be allowed. Appropriate topics would include reflections on the four years at TPHS, special thanks to teachers, friends and family for support, etc.
- The speech you write, should it be selected, must be the one you give at the graduation ceremony. A copy of that speech must be given to Mr. Thornton upon selection.
- Evaluation of the speeches and presentations will be judged according to the rubrics on the back of this form.
- The decisions of the Graduation Committee will be final.

Please return the bottom portion of this form, with your speech, on or before Tuesday, May 12th to Patricia Hargraves in the Student Store.
