- Foundation High School Plan with Endorsements

  - 4 credits of English
  - 4 credits of Math
    - · Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, & One Additional Math
  - 4 credits of Science
    - Biology, Chemistry, Physics, & One Additional Science
  - 4 credits of Social Studies
    - World Geography, World History, US History, Government, & Economics
  - Two credits of the same Foreign Language
  - One Fine Art credit
  - One PE credit
  - Health (half credit)
  - Five and a half Elective credits

#### Credits

- Credits are awarded at the end of each semester.
- Each semester of high school you have the potential to earn 4 credits. You can earn a total of 8 credits for the entire school year (unless you are enrolled in a double blocked course such as band or athletics).
- In order to earn a credit, you must receive a grade of 70 or higher.
- Semester grades are calculated by averaging together your 1<sup>st</sup> 9 weeks grade, 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 weeks grade, and your semester exam grade.

#### **GPA** and Class Rank

- GPA=Grade Point Average
- Your GPA is based on the classes you take and the grades you make in those classes.
