### **CALL TO CONFESSION**

\_\_\_ We hear the pastor remind us that we all do things that we are sorry for.



#### PRAYER OF CONFESSION

We tell God we are sorry for the wrong things we do in our Confession of Sin. We read together.

God of Moses and Elijah, God of mystery and wonder, we give thanks for the many ways that You make Yourself known to us. For Moses, the burning bush was a sign of Your presence and call. Peter, James and John saw You in Jesus one day on a mountaintop, transfigured by light and hidden by clouds. We often yearn for clear signs of Your presence, for shining epiphanies rather than faint glimmers. We would prefer to live by certainty rather than by faith, yet we recall in this place that the faithful have gone out trusting You, not knowing where You were leading. And in our best moments, we know that we too must live by faith. Teach us, O God, to trust in that still, small voice as well as the light that we are given. Take our hands and walk with us, that we may follow You as far as we can see, and then to walk where we cannot see. Heal our sorrows; calm our fears; set us upon paths that we can walk in trust, and help us to be Your people, to listen to Your word, and to count upon Your great love. In Jesus' name. Amen.


#### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM
