- 2. All cats aged over six months must be registered, microchipped and sterilised in accordance with the Cat Act (2011). Penalties apply for not complying with the Act;
- 3. There is a limit of three (3) cats per household;
- 4. The City of Karratha must be advised immediately of any changes of details (i.e. deceased, ownership, address etc.);
